- David suggests the schedule be pushed out by 1 week so a vote can be taken on the requirements 29 Sept 2020
- Full TSC meeting next week, 30 minutes for release meeting next week
- Question does the TSC agree to slip M1 by one week?
 - No objections were raised, #agreed

- Qiao Fu was unable to hear David easily.
 - David clarified that CIRV (RELREQ-4 and 5) are categorized correctly and Fu Qiao confirmed
 - Al Morton confirms RELREQ-6 is correctly categorized
 - RELREQ-9 is categorized as VSPERF only as well
 - ° RELREQ-13 will have a follow up meeting with James Gu and Al Morton

Marketing Priorities
